South Beloit, IL, October 10, 2008 – Libertarian U.S. Senate Candidate Larry Stafford has announced his intention to participate in a debate with other third party candidates for U.S. Senate on MillerPolitics.com.

This week the two major party candidates for U.S. Senate, Democratic incumbent Sen. Dick Durbin and Republican Dr. Steve Sauerberg debated but Stafford, Cummings and Koppe, all of whom will appear on the ballot, were excluded.
